

**ST. CATHARINE SCHOOL  
ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT**

Registration and continued attendance at St. Catharine School requires the following of both  
parents and students:

- 1) **PARENTAL COOPERATION:** Parents are required to cooperate with the school by adhering to policies, procedures and regulations as outlined in the School Handbook and clarified from time to time in the regular newsletter. Parents are further expected to assure open communication between the home and the school, attend conferences and cooperate with the school staff.
- 2) **PARENTAL SUPPORT:** Parents are expected to support projects and activities designed to raise funds in support of the school budget. Given the fact that no family pays the full per-pupil cost, it is expected that all families will become actively involved with at least one of the major projects sponsored by the Home and School Association. Parents are further expected to become involved, according to their talents and availability, in any of the other school volunteer support programs.
- 3) **STUDENT ABILITY:** Students must be willing and able to participate in the educational program within the general range of ability of the student body. Students must be able to function satisfactorily within the confines of the program and its resources. We will neither admit nor retain students unable or unwilling to respond appropriately to the school program, nor whose needs cannot be effectively met within the program or resources.
- 4) **STUDENT CONDUCT:** Appropriate conduct is expected at all times, with particular emphasis on the demonstrated respect for the Church and its teachings. The Code of Conduct and supporting policies outline behavioral expectations for all students. Further, all students are required to participate in the religious life of the school including religion classes, liturgical events and service projects.
- 5) **TUITION:** Tuition must be paid in full according to school policy and tuition guidelines. Students will be dismissed for nonpayment of tuition. Parishioners are defined as those registered, participating members of St. Catharine Parish who support the parish financially. Those claiming parishioner status are subject to periodic review to determine continued eligibility for parishioner rates. Noncontributing parishioners will be charged the non-parishioner rate.
