NOTES FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Hard to believe that the next edition of this will be in your hands on the first day of school! As most of you are aware, this will be the year of flexibility as it pertains to our building project. We will stay in contact with you via email (School Speak) if there are changes in either drop off or pick up of students. These could change depending on where we are in terms of parking lot issues. As a reminder, Wednesday, August 21 is the first day of school with a 1:00 dismissal (no lunch served that day). In addition, we are reminding parents that you are welcome to join us for morning prayer on August 21 (Wednesday) and doughnuts and coffee in the cafeteria (following morning prayer).

We are also starting a new program with Food Service Solutions. There will be more details and parent information after this program completes set up. We are hopeful to start it on August 22 (the first day of cafeteria lunches). We already have in place the finger fob that students use when they move through the cafeteria lunch line. This is run by Food Service Solutions. Additional information on how parents sign up to use this company to directly deposit money to be used for school lunches and milk will be made available to our parents by Monday. All our high schools and many of the elementary schools are already using this program. On-line payment should make it easier for parents to monitor lunch accounts and easier for families to see when their child buys either lunch or milk. At this time, it will not be mandatory but certainly a service that many parents have asked for. Again, more information and directions on setting up your account will be available to you by Monday of next week.

The forms (Emergency and the Parent/Student Handbook Form) need to be electronically signed and dated EACH and EVERY school year even if the information does not change.

Tuesday, August 20th from 5:00pm to 6:30pm


